Students are respectful to each other.

- Listening attentively to others' opinions
- Complimenting each others' ideas, thoughts, and efforts
- Extending kindness and compassion to one another

Students seem interested in what is being taught.

- Answering questions
- Asking for clarity
- Contributing ideas and thoughts

Students appear happy and relaxed.

- Talking and participating in class discussions
- Smiling and laughing when appropriate
- Having good posture (head high, sitting up)

Students are respectful to the teacher.

- Listening attentively
- Using respectful language
- Being open to new ideas and concepts

Students act responsibly.

- Coming to class prepared with necessary books and materials
- Arriving to class on time
- Following established rules and norms of behavior

Students freely express their thoughts and ideas.

- Offering different opinions or answers
- Participating in class discussions
- Being nonjudgmental
