

Advisory Ambassadors provides an important opportunity for Student Voices to be valued and heard at school. Every month two Ambassadors will be selected from each advisory class. Twice a month the Advisory Ambassadors will attend a Principal's Aspirations Council (PAC) meeting with the Principal and elected Student Council members during advisory.

Prior to the PAC meeting, Ambassadors are asked to gather information from their advisory class on the following questions and be prepared to share at the meeting:

What is going well at school?
What ideas do you have for improving school?

Keep in mind the [Voice Definition](#) as you gather this feedback from your advisory class:

1. Sharing thoughts & ideas in an environment underpinned by trust & respect
2. Offering realistic suggestions for the good of the whole
3. Accepting responsibility for not only what is said, but what needs to be done

Student Council and Administration will also have information they will share and ask Ambassadors to take back to and share with their advisory class.

Ambassadors may also be called upon during their month of service to support the school in other ways such as helping with school events, leading school tours, participating in focus groups, etc.

CREATE A LIST



During advisory, create a list of what is going well and school issues students believe need to be addressed. Have your advisory class create realistic suggestions/solutions to the issues that they are ready to bring to the table.

DESCRIBE THE PAC

The PAC stands for the Principal's Advisory and Aspirations Council. The PAC meets twice a month to discuss current school issues and devise solutions to those issues.



SELECT 2 ADVISORY AMBASSADORS



The 2 Advisory Ambassadors will attend the bi-monthly meetings to represent their advisory class and bring their ideas, suggestions, and solutions to the table. Ambassadors will report back to their advisory the following week.

2 New Ambassadors will be selected each month.

AMBASSADORS ATTEND THE PAC MEETINGS

The PAC meets every other week during Advisory. Ambassadors, and anyone else interested, will attend to speak on behalf of their advisory class and partner with the PAC, Ms. Welsh, and Ms. Brait to find solutions. Zoom information will be shared.
