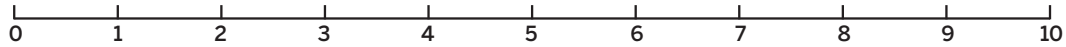

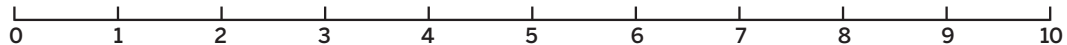

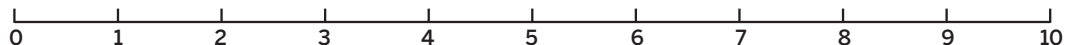
How do you build positive relationships with students?

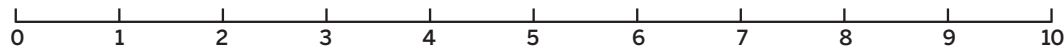

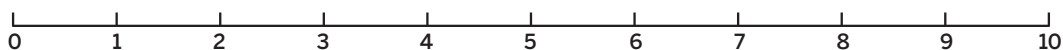
