



Student Voice & Aspirations On-Site Review

Full Day In-Person Consultation

Overview

This process is available for schools that have previously engaged in Quaglia Institute professional learning sessions and are familiar with the Quaglia Student Voice & Aspirations work. During this session, a Quaglia Institute senior staff member will assist your school in gauging the current status of the Voice Process implementation and the extent to which student voice and aspirations are embedded across the school. This assessment will include understanding how your school's goals, vision, and improvement planning can most effectively embrace student voice within teaching and learning practices throughout the school. School leaders/teams will work directly with Quaglia staff to craft an action plan that aligns with their contextual needs and capacity for change.

Full Day Agenda

- Classroom visits and student interviews
- Leadership meeting
- Review of student voice in teaching and learning strategies
- Review of school documentation to integrate the Voice Process within whole school planning
- Development of action plans for implementation
- Student voice data discussion

Quaglia Institute Responsibilities

- Host an online collaborative planning meeting prior to the full-day session to prepare for on-site visit;
- Dedicate a senior member of the Quaglia Institute staff for one full day of consultation;
- Share instructional strategies to promote growth and sustainability of student voice across the school;
- Provide additional readings/resources related to the school's needs;
- Write a follow-up report to support the school's next steps on their Student Voice & Aspirations journey;
- Send a written follow-up report via email to support the school's next steps on their Student Voice & Aspirations journey;
- Present findings to whole school staff in an online session within three weeks of consultation (if school chooses to);
- Conduct two one-hour follow up sessions online within 12 months to support implementation of next steps and continue the focus on Voice Process as a whole-school strategy; and
- Connect schools around the world in order to learn from each other and strengthen voice and aspirations work.
