

## **STUDENT VOICE SURVEY**

The Student Voice surveys assess student aspirations by asking students questions based on each of the 8 Conditions That Make a Difference across an entire school. By asking students how they perceive their school environment, Student Voice provides educators with a powerful tool for understanding both what motivates and inspires students to achieve and how well students believe their school is meeting those objectives. These online surveys take about 15 minutes to complete and provide survey administrators with real-time reports. By using the reports, teams of educators and students can work together to develop shared objectives and inspire meaningful improvements within their schools.

### **Belonging**
