Question:

Can leadership be heroic even without being the star performer?



UNSUNG HERO SCENARIO 4

The Group Project Organizer

During a group assignment, one student quietly keeps everyone on track, divides tasks fairly, and helps others finish their parts.

Question:

Why do these kinds of contributions often go unnoticed?



UNSUNG HERO SCENARIO 5

The Upstander

A student hears someone making fun of a classmate. Instead of laughing along, they say something supportive and change the tone of the conversation.

Question:

What makes speaking up difficult in situations like this?



UNSUNG HERO SCENARIO 6

The Encourager

A student notices their friend struggling after getting a low grade and reminds them that one test doesn't define them.

Question:

How can encouragement change someone's mindset?



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The School Event Supporter

A student regularly attends school plays, games, and concerts to support friends and classmates, even when they're not directly involved.

Question:

Why does showing up for others matter?



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The Note Sharer

A classmate misses several days of school due to illness. Another student takes time to share notes and explain what they missed.

Question:

Why is helping someone catch up an important act of community?



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The Behind-the-Scenes Contributor

During a school event, some students get attention for performing or presenting, while others quietly handle setup, technology, or cleanup.

Question:

Why are behind-the-scenes roles important for success?
