



Would You Rather: Teamwork

Directions:

Have students line up across the room.

Read one statement at a time and then have those who chose the first option step forward and those who chose the second step back. Remind students to think beyond sports teams – for example, a group you are working with on a class project.

Ask a few students to share why they chose their specific answers.

1. Would you rather work with a team that talks too much or not enough?
2. Would you rather give all the directions or follow all the directions?
3. Would you rather have a super organized teammate or a super creative one?
4. Would you rather communicate only by text or only face-to-face?
5. Would you rather do extra work to ensure a good grade or risk a lower grade to keep things fair?
6. Would you rather have one unreliable teammate or three average ones?
7. Would you rather finish early with mistakes or last minute but perfect?
8. Would you rather be the leader every time or never be the leader?
9. Would you rather confront a teammate directly or go through the teacher?
10. Would you rather redo someone else's work quietly or ask them to fix it?
11. Would you rather work with your friends or people you don't know well?



12. Would you rather have a strict leader or no leader at all?
13. Would you rather work in total silence or with music playing?
14. Would you rather meet in person or collaborate online?
15. Would you rather present to the class or create a video instead?
16. Would you rather be the smartest person on your team or the one who learns the most?
17. Would you rather succeed as a team but not get recognized or stand out individually but the team struggles?
18. Would you rather have clear roles assigned or let everyone figure it out naturally?
19. Would you rather have snacks during work time or extra break time after?
20. Would you rather work harder or work smarter (even if it looks like less effort)?
