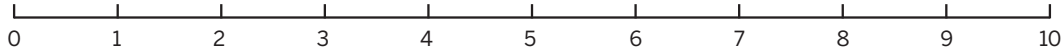




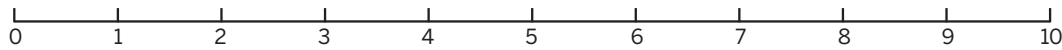
CURIOSITY & CREATIVITY SELF-ASSESSMENT

1. I encourage all students to ask questions.



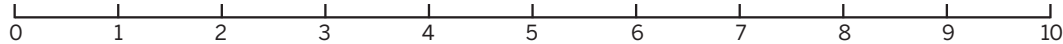
What strategies do you use to help quiet and introverted students feel comfortable asking questions?

2. I provide opportunities for students to be creative.



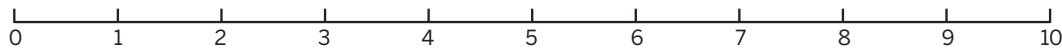
How do your assessments support opportunities for students to express their creativity?

3. I challenge students to consider multiple perspectives and solutions to complex problems.



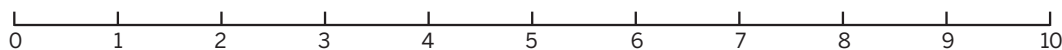
How do you encourage students to "think outside the box" and embrace divergent thinking?

4. I provide meaningful extended learning opportunities for students (i.e. homework, additional practice, etc.)



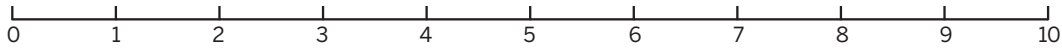
What input do you seek from students regarding extended learning beyond class time?

5. I teach students how to identify factual information and reliable online sources.



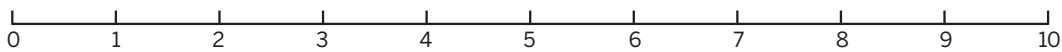
How do you teach students to use AI in a responsible and ethical manner?

6. Our school promotes a creative learning environment.



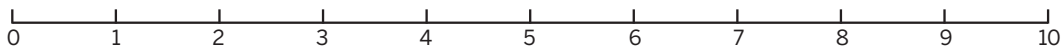
What does it look like when creativity is valued at a school? What opportunities do students have to share their creative gifts within your school community?

7. Students are regularly encouraged to share their ideas for improving the school experience.



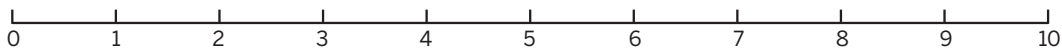
What opportunities exist for students who are not in leadership roles to share their ideas?
