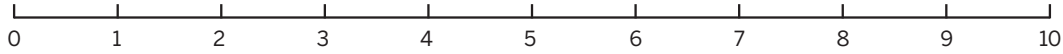


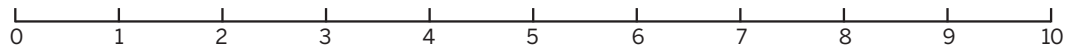

1. I am passionate about teaching.



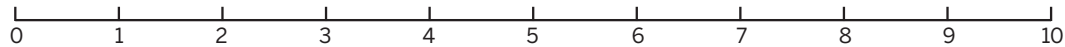
What would your students say you enjoy the most about teaching?

2. I know my students' interests and passions.



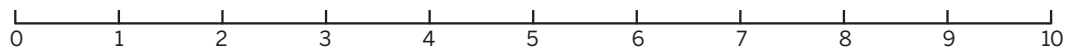
How do you connect curriculum to students' real-world interests and experiences?

3. I prioritize time for learning new things.



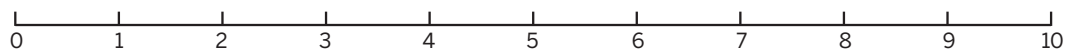
What is one new thing you recently learned that was interesting to you?

4. I learn from students.



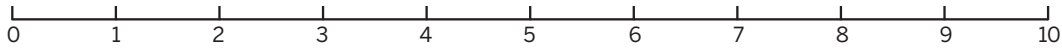
How do you routinely show students that you are invested in learning from them? What is one thing you recently learned from a student?

5. I use student feedback to create dynamic learning experiences.



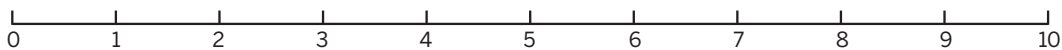
What role do students play in creating engaging learning opportunities in your class?

6. Our school involves students in planning and delivering school-wide events.



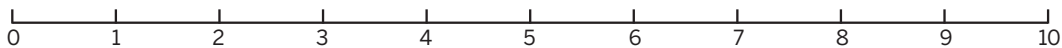
How do students share the responsibility with adults for creating engaging events at school?

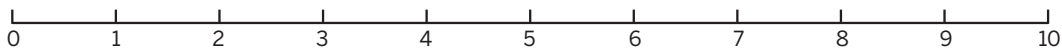
