



Fall into a Winning Season

The following actions provide guidance and potential next steps for implementation of professional learning from the ATL session on Engagement into practice in your classrooms, schools, and beyond. Schedule time with your principal to discuss the action and implementation of next steps in your school. Be prepared to share about the actions you will take at the start of our next ATL session.

- **Take action on one of the Engagement scenarios linked to the Highly Effective Classroom Framework.** Adapt one of the scenarios shared during the Engagement session, or create a new scenario you can bring to life! The key is to identify an area in your school that could be improved by applying your learning from the Engagement session AND intentionally connect these actions to an area of the Highly Effective Classroom Framework.
- **Design & deliver professional learning to your colleagues.** This could be sharing some aspect of what you have learned during the Self Worth session, or something connected to your school's CSIP or Strategic Plan. This professional learning could be delivered to the full faculty or during school-based professional development. Feel free to take any of the resources provided and adapt them to what best matches with the goals of your school, what best meets the contextual needs of your colleagues, time you have to present, and learning objectives for the session. Possible content from the Engagement session that could be shared with staff:
 - Fun & Excitement
 - Curiosity & Creativity
 - Spirit of Adventure
 - The Balanced Model for Engagement (Relationships, Content, Clarity)
 - Other ideas
- **Be a Teacher-preneur.** Find a way to bring your Teacher-preneur dreams—or even a small part of your ultimate dreams to life!
- **Read the book *Total Participation Techniques*.** Come to the next ATL session prepared to share a strategy you have tried in your classroom.
- **Don't be a Bore in 2034!** Don't forget to prepare for the Mock Reunion at our next session.
